December 28-29, 2018

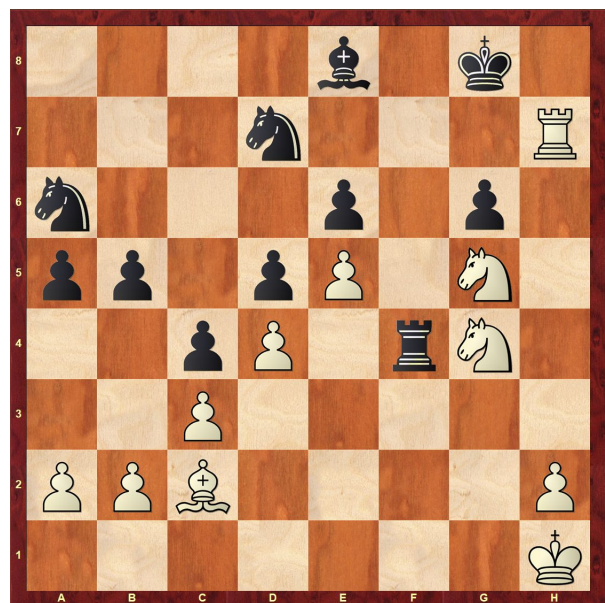

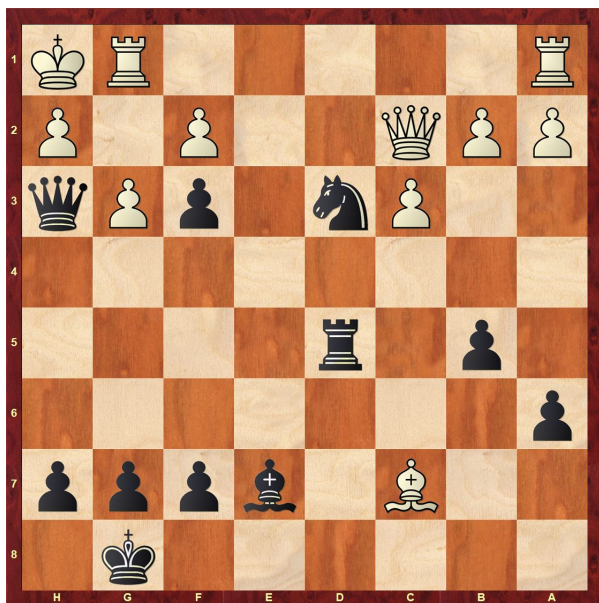

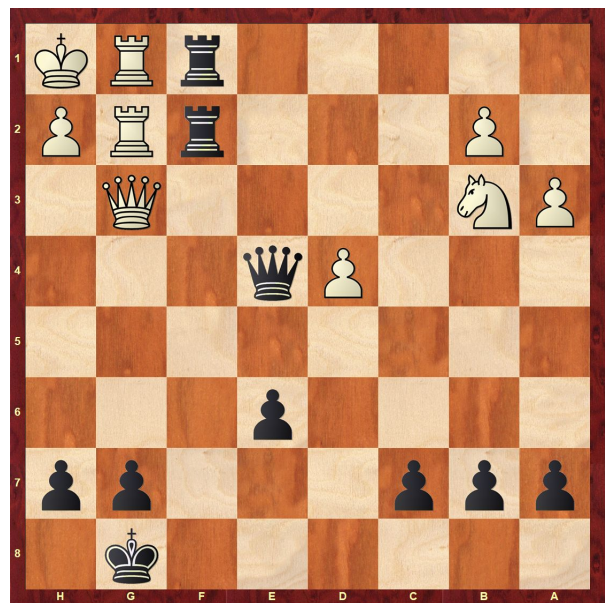
1. Black to play, mate in 2



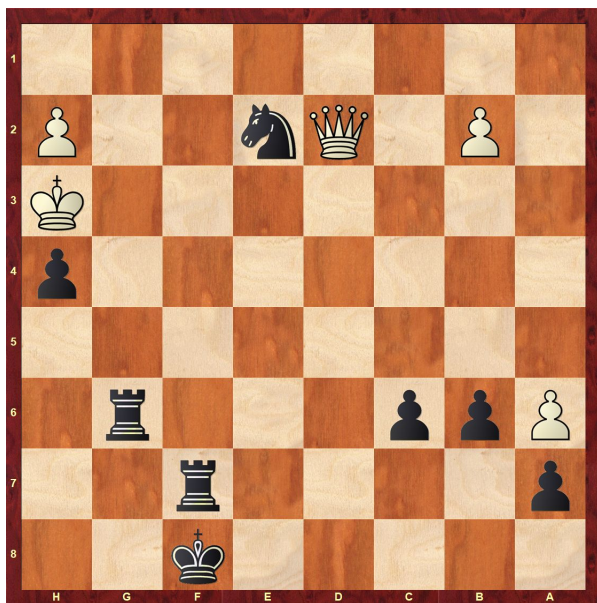
2. White to play, mate in 2



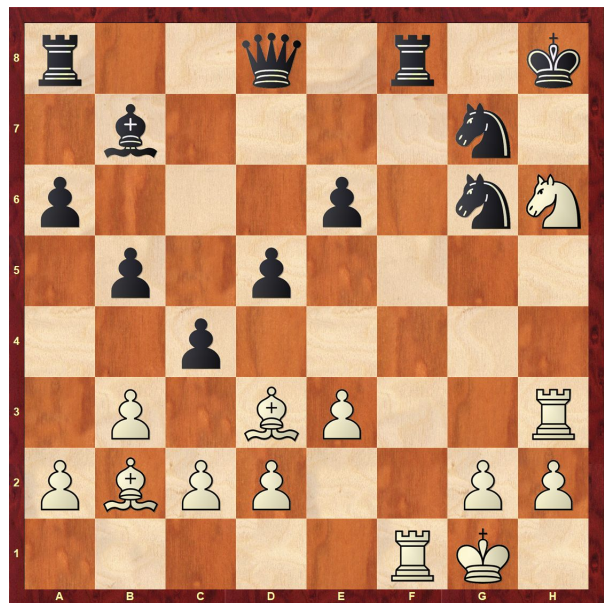
3. Black to play, mate in 2
