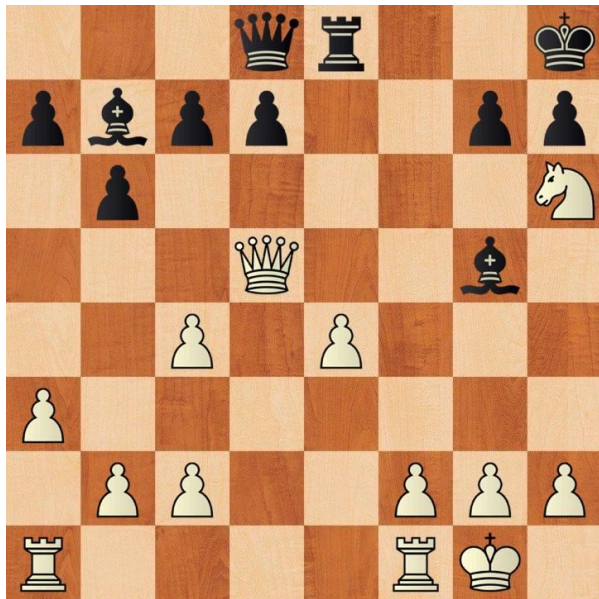
Alberta Junior Chess Championship

November 17-18, 2018

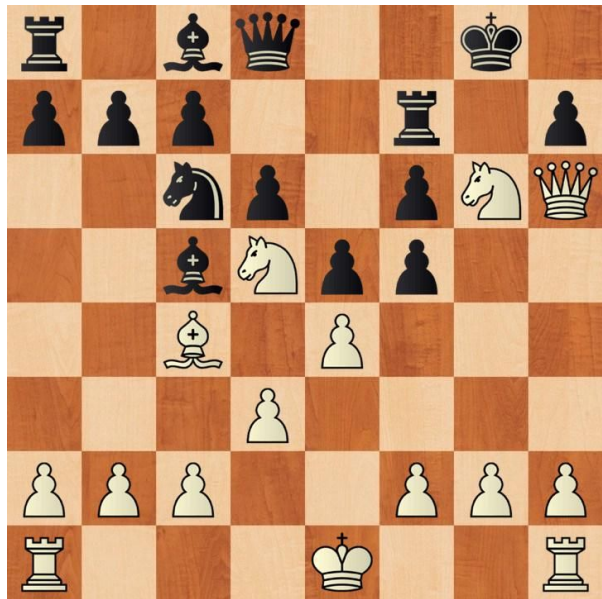

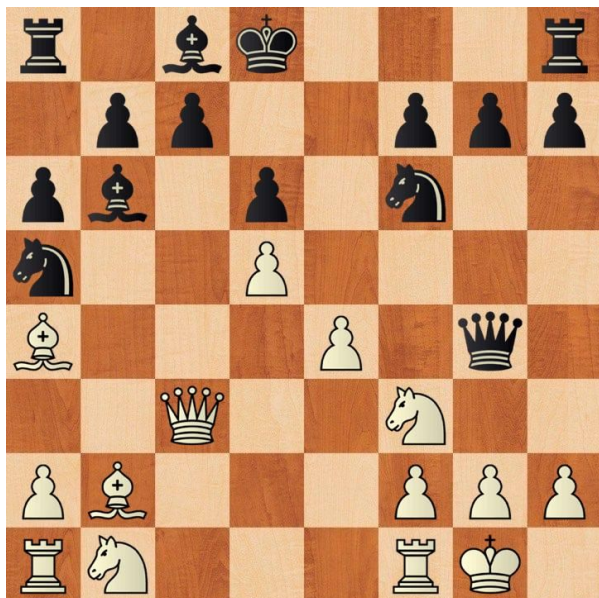
All puzzles this month are White to play, mate in 2!



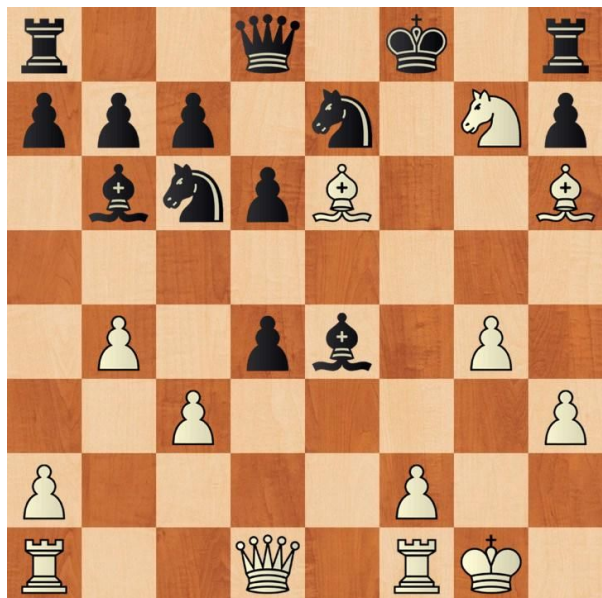
1. White to play, mate in 2



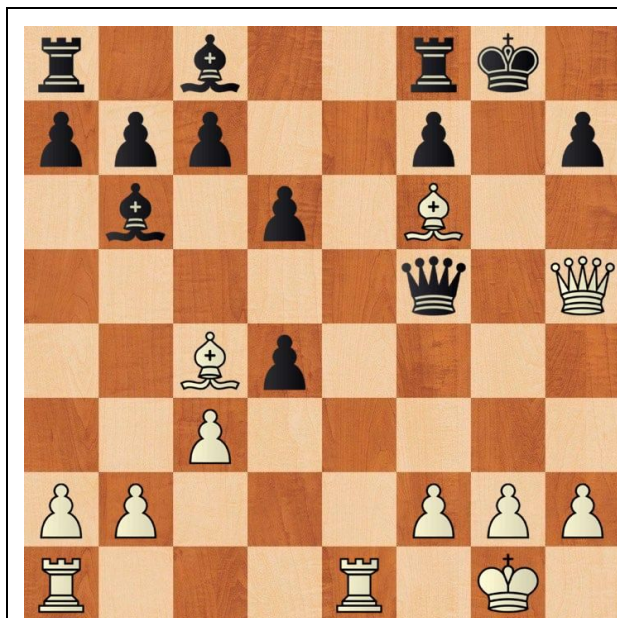
2. White to play, mate in 2



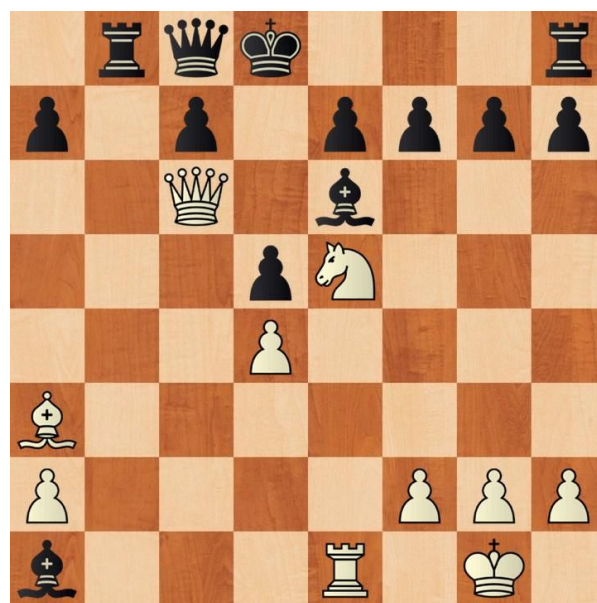
